

Environmental Assessment Checklist for B-Permit Projects <u>Without</u> Previous California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Review

NOTE: This form is only required if there has been no CEQA review or findings from a government agency, like City Planning. Additional information can be found by reviewing the B-Permit Technical Procedures in the Development Services Procedures Manual.

This checklist will be used to aid BOE in CEQA review and findings and determine whether any significant environmental impacts could result from the proposed project or action. This form and its attachments shall be filled out and submitted by the Applicant through BOE's ProjectDox system (Environmental Documents folder) during the Bond Estimate phase.

Please include the following, as applicable, to aid in the project's review and findings:

- Environmental Assessment Checklist (this form)
- Proposed plans (conceptual or schematic is acceptable) showing the full project including private property and the public right of way.
- Copy of applicable Los Angeles Department of Building and Safety (LADBS) documents including the Building Permit Application and/or Clearance Summary Worksheet

- **Other pertinent information to assist in determining environmental impacts**
- 1. **Description / Purpose of Project:** Describe the scope of the entire project (private property and public right of way). If the project could result in any adverse environmental effects or public objections, please provide these details as well.



- 2. **Permits/Project Approvals:** Please check all the following subsequent or subordinate City permits or approvals which may be necessary to complete the project.
 - Building permit (LADBS)
 - Haul Route permit (LADBS)
 - □ Tree Removal permit (StreetsLA)
 - Tree removal in the public right of way

 - Excavation E or U permit (BOE)

E. Square footage of existing buildings to be demolished and proposed new construction.
